Introduction

The phenomenon of self-representation of citizens produces a risk of overloading the courts with cases that are inadmissible, have low stakes or have low chances of success. In order to overcome these difficulties, many tools are being developed in the field of citizens' self-representation and must therefore be evaluated in terms of their effectiveness, relevance and satisfaction rates of the target audience.

Our first case study is Community Legal Education Ontario (CLEO)'s new tool: the Family Law Guided Pathway (FLGP)3, using A2J Author technology. This is the first of many guided pathways to family court forms that CLEO has created to help people complete family court forms on child support, custody, access, and other issues. We are helping CLEO in assessing the successes, failures and potential improvements of the tool.

The Montreal Cyberjustice Laboratory and CLEO have developed an evaluation model, inspired by various existing frameworks, and discussed in our paper entitled: "A Step-by-Step Evaluation Model for Legal Tools" (available upon request).4

1. Our Goals

GOAL #1

An inventory of legal tools using technology to serve SRLs.

GOAL #2

Evaluation of their effectiveness and larger social impact on access to justice.

GOAL#3

Development of an evaluation model and best practices for empirical assessment of legal tools.

Our mission is to provide tools (evaluation model, guide, inventories) in order to facilitate the work of entities wishing to assist SRLs.



Background

An extensive literature review was undertaken. Over 150 sources were reviewed, including studies on online legal tools using the same platform as CLEO (A2J Author) or other technologies (HotDos), as well as other types of legal assistance (legal aid, legal clinics). We focused mainly on Nord America (Canada and the United States), but also looked beyond North America (United Kingdom, Asia, Africa, South America). The scope of the literature review was broad, so as to cover a wide range of legal tools and materials for SRLs, offered online or off-line.

2.1 Legal Tools

The increase in the number of SRLs, in Canada, as well as in other jurisdictions, has led to the development of various legal tools to assist them. These tools range from general legal information and tailored guides to help with court forms or case management, and even assistance with the judicial process or settlement. While the traditional legal system was paper-based, resources and tools for both lawyers and SRLs are increasingly available online. Legal documents can be completed electronically (e.g. interactive court forms, document assembly platforms, triage portals and e filing systems), and hearings and dispute resolution tools may also proceed online. The question of which tools are effective (and which are not) is important not only for legal services providers, but for all stakeholders, including policy makers and the citizens they intend to serve.

2.2 Services Offered

The types of services for SRLs vary widely: from help with legal aid applications to filling out legal forms or drafting procedures in various legal situations. This inventory focuses on A2J Guided Interviews in the United States. In addition to A2J Guided Interviews, the vast majority also provide other kind of services, such as legal information, forms templates (Word, PDF), online assistance or referral to appropriate resources (lawyer, legal aid, legal clinics). The most popular areas of law are: family law, housing, debts, and wills.



3. Out History

A2J Author was created by Chicago-Kent College of Law's Center for Access to Justice ("Chigago-Kent"), in partnership with the Center for Computer-Assisted Legal Instruction ("CALI").⁵

4. A2J Author


4.1 Where is it used?

A2J Author software is freely available to any non-profit organizations, such as CLEO. It aims at improving access to justice for SRLs, but may also be used by legal professionals, such as lawyers or court staff. A2J Author is largely used in United States, by over 40 states, and now in Canada.

4.2 How does it work?

A2J Author works as an interactive interview. Users are asked a series of questions to help them complete their court forms correctly. Each question includes legal information explained in plain language, so that users can understand it and answer the next question. Every time users are completing a step, they move closer to the courthouse. When completed, the answers are used to generate all the relevant forms, at once. Thus, users need to enter only once the required information, which is used to generate several personalized forms. CLEO's FLGP also generates a next steps checklist, tailored to the user's situation.

4.3 Is it Compatible with Other Systems?

Yes. In most States, A2J Guided Interview is uploaded to the Law Help Interactive (LHI)⁷ server and combined with HotDocs form to create an interactive interview for court forms. Some states have even integrated A2J Author into the court system, with e-filing and case management systems.

Image 2. A2J Auhor Compatibility with the Other Servers⁸





Image 3. E-Filing with A2J Author⁹


5.1 How to Find A2J Guided Interviews?



6. Evaluation

A2J AUTHOR HITS 6,000,000 USAGES!



A2J Author has reached an impressive milestone. In the past 15 years, A2J Guided Interviews have been run more than 6 million times to help low income pro se litigants fill out over 3 million court forms.

6.1 Methods

Most common methods for assessing A2J Author platform are: testing, website metrics (page view, session time, statistics for completed forms, et.c) as well as users' feedback (open comments, surveys). Tracking files into the court system is less common, since it requires more investment in logistics and the collaboration of the courthouse.

6.2 Limitations

Evaluations mainly focus on efficiency, rather than outcomes or larger social impact. The typical questions asked when evaluating an A2J Author tool concern its implementation, such as usefulness, accessibility, and user satisfaction with the tool: Where did you find out about this tool? Was it hard or easy to use? Did you find the information you were looking for? Socio-demographics data is also collected via users accounts, so as to assess who is using the tool and for what type of legal problem. However, data collected is not always published or publicly available.







Conclusion

There are many reasons for using A2J Author. The software is freely available to non-profit organizations. The interface is user-friendly. Privacy and security features are robust. And it has institutional support.

A2J Guided Interviews aim at improving access to justice for SRLs. How to assess its impact? We address this question in another report. We developed an evaluation model that builds on lessons learned from previous research, and that can be adapted to any tool development stage.
